1.2 P2ENDURE Public Website


LinkedIn Group



1.4 BUILD UP Portal

The BUILD UP initiative was established by the European Commission in 2009 to support EU Member States in implementing the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD). The portal brings together new practitioners and professional associations in order to exchange best working practices and knowledge and to transfer tools and resources.

During the EASME Contractors Meeting, that took place in Brussels on 18th of October 2016, the BUILD UP portal was presented as an important dissemination tool.

The project coordinator (DEMO Consultants) has created personal profiles for team members involved within the project and a separate account for P2ENDURE project. Relevant articles and descriptions of the products/tools and the demonstration cases can be shared through this profile. The P2ENDURE project has also been published in the Explore section of the BUILD UP portal (where various services with respect to exploitation of results, incentives, etc. are introduced). 1.5 Protocols for CMS and updates of the public website

The role and task distribution concerning the public website are described in the Description of Action of the P2ENDURE project.

In short, the content management will be done by DEMO Consultants (Coordinator), who is responsible for the implications of external communications from the project. In addition, DMO ensures the website hosting and technical support. When documents need to be uploaded on the public website, DMO will upload them first on the DMO-server due to security reasons and make them available for download from the P2ENDURE website through links.

DEMO Consultants will keep the public website online until 2 years after the project's completion. Depending on the exploitation plan that will be developed in the course of the project, this post-project website may be transferred into a commercial website for offering and selling of the project results.

Initial schedule for public website updates:

- M1 (September 2016): website launching
- M3 (November 2016): first update

The P2ENDURE website will be updated every 3 months within the project duration.

In 2017 - 2020: the updates will take place every year in February, May, August and November.

• M47 (August 2020): final update and transfer to post-project (commercial) website

Information on Content Management System (CMS), accessible by webmaster

CMS is a computer application that supports the creation and modification of digital content using a common user interface and thus supporting multiple users. DEMO Consultants as webmaster owns the login credentials to work with this CMS. DMO uses a free cross-browser WYSIWYG (What you See Is What You Get) editor.






1.6 P2ENDURE SharePoint internal website



1.7 Access to the SharePoint internal website

There are two ways to access this project website:

- Web-enabled:
 - By logging in with own credentials through the public website
 http://www.p2endure-project.eu under Login Consortium Project Website, or
 - By accessing directly the SharePoint via https://www.p2endure-project.org/
 A window will open where registered members will log in with their credentials.
- On The Go (iPad/iPhone App)
 - SharePlus Office Mobile Client app (available in App Store for free for the lite version) is an easy to use office app On The Go for retrieving and editing SharePoint documents on mobile devices. This can be easily done with or without network connectivity and will sync the changes securely when back at the office. If a file was changed by someone else while out of the office, the app will detect the collision and ask what version to keep.

 PowerPoint template to set up internal and external presentations








